This second-level workshop by the Alternatives to Violence Project is intended for people who have completed a Basic workshop. In this 3-day workshop, we focus on the underlying causes of violence, both in ourselves and in the world around us, such as fear, anger and power. In this fun, interactive workshop we explore deeper ways to resolve conflict. Participants who complete this workshop qualify for the next level workshop, where you can train to be an AVP facilitator and bring these skills to your own community or workplace.
